## RESPECT AND TEAMSHIP

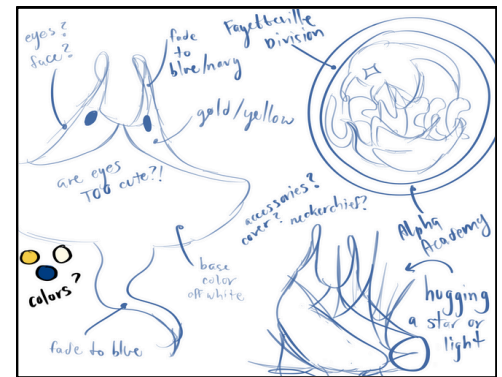
